#### MARCH LT MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

**FINANCIAL REPORT:** Offering has increased for the month although year -to-date giving is still down somewhat. The LT voted unanimously to donate \$500.00 from \$1,400.00 current undesignated funds from missions fund to Ukraine Relief, reserving remainder for other potential disaster relief in the future.

**OUTREACH/MISSIONS:** The decision to again postpone General Conference to 2024 was recently announced. Pastor Nate indicated that Bishops and Conferences would be petitioning **General Conference** to allow each conference to make their decisions relative to separation now. Regarding inclusivity discussions, the next scheduled Time To Talk is set for March 27, 2022, from 2PM to 4PM, to be followed by Small discussion groups on April 14, from 6PMo 8PM.

**An Easter Egg Hunt** is scheduled for 2PM on Saturday, April 16, 2022, in the church yard. Donations of wrapped candy and small trinkets to stuff into Easter Eggs will be accepted and appreciated.

It was suggested that HOPE UMC be represented in the **Edwardsburg Memorial Day Parade** with cards and treats to be handed out by participants.

**Coffee Time** will commence in Reese Hall on March 27, 2022 following the 8:30 Service.

Chris Edgerton and Mike Morgan volunteered to represent Hope UMC at **Annual Conference** scheduled for June 1 through June 4, 2022, at Grand Traverse Resort.

**TRUSTEE REPORT:** Dynamic will be retained to check and service all heating units in both buildings. **Clean-Up** days will resume commencing March 26, 2022, from 8AM to Noon, with lunch provided. It is anticipated that the existing accumulation of mulch will be spread on the trails behind the church that day.




