Newly appointed HUMC Pastor Rob Snodgrass describes himself as a follower of Jesus who happens to be "a Marine, aircraft mechanic, car salesman, and a pastor" yes an unusual combination. So – what is Pastor Rob's background?

He grew up on a farm in Elkhart County, went to school in Nappanee, graduating from Northwood, showed and trained horses at a nationally ranked skill level. Deciding a new environment was in order, Rob joined the Marines intending to make a career of military service. But after 6 years both his parents developed serious health issues and he was released from his military commitment to come back to Indiana to care for them.

The following years found him juggling several roles – caregiver, husband, single parent – while working at various jobs in industrial maintenance, manufacturing, and sales. He held the positions in upper management for many years before starting his own companies. He says a benefit from this stressful life was learning to deal with adversity. But life wasn't always hard — while indulging in one of his hobbies/interests, archery, Rob met another single parent, Kathe at the 3-D archery range he owned, and soon became involved with her and her son.

The couple were part of the early days of Granger Community Church when that congregation was meeting in a movie theater; then participated in the move down the road to the present GCC campus and became very close to GCC founding Pastor Mark Beeson who had introduced them at the 3-D range. When Kathe and Rob asked Pastor Beeson to marry them, he declined explaining that his administrative duties had become so time-consuming, they had forced him to stop performing weddings. However, when Rob and Kathe explained their wedding plan, Pastor B reconsidered. The 1996 wedding was held on an elevated stand on a 3D archery range with the attendants on the stairs leading to the platform floor and the pastor, bride and groom at an elevated (and surely an excited) level. The reception following took the form of a hog roast.

While Kathe prayed for Rob to come closer to God and the church as he worked at his sporting goods stores and used car dealership, in 2004 they moved to the Vandalia area to Kathe's family's property at Kirk Lake. Rob, with some help, built a log cabin home and they transitioned to the Cassopolis UMC. One Sunday Kathe, travelling to Hope to meet a friend, was so taken with Pastor Jeff Reese's message and personality she encouraged Rob to visit Hope; she strongly felt the two men would share a connection.

And how right she was. Rob, under Jeff's mentoring, became a licensed lay speaker. He then was asked to fill in at Morris Chapel UMC north of Niles every other week. Next, the District Superintendent asked him to add Grace UMC to his charge, followed by a request to add Wesley UMC. Now Rob was caring for a three-point charge and had become a full-time pastor. Then Pastor Rob, with the example of his Jeff Reese training, managed a merger of Grace and Wesley creating New Journey UMC as of January 1, 2020. His next challenge was managing his congregations through the COVID pandemic; finding creative ways to worship and provide support while all remained healthy.

Rob loves most anything outdoors in God's creation — hunting, fishing, Morel Mushroom hunting, skiing, hiking, horseback riding, snowmobiling, and enjoys sharing that love with his grandchildren. We of Hope look forward to renewing our relationships with Pastor Rob and his family which now includes, in addition to daughter Jakayla and sons Derek and Jeff, six grandchildren ages 3 to 10.
